



Dorchester House - Arrivals briefing

Fire Safety

- If you discover a fire, dial 999 immediately and/or activate one of the call points.
- If you hear a fire/smoke alarm, evacuate the building immediately
- Go straight to the assembly point
- Remain outside at the assembly point until told otherwise by staff or the fire brigade

- No Smoking
- No Candles
- No Incense
- Do not tamper with any fire safety equipment.

Smoking policy

All of Dorchester House is smoke and vape free. If you do smoke and/or vape please do so outside in the designated smoking area.

Drugs Policy

BU and Dorchester House are unable to tolerate the use or sale of illegal drugs including all psychoactive substances (including those previously known as 'Legal Highs') covered under the Psychoactive Substances Act 2016. Use of these substances on BU property will result in eviction from your accommodation and could lead to expulsion from the University.

Alcohol on the street

It is an offence to consume alcohol in public areas in Bournemouth, including the grounds of the Dorchester House itself. Police checks are undertaken and penalties issued, so if you are going to drink alcohol we strongly recommend you keep this in mind.
